## **NAG 1 Curriculum Requirements and Student Achievements**

### **1.1 Curriculum Delivery**

#### **RATIONALE**

All students have a right to the best possible education through quality programmes. Through the provision of quality programmes students will reach their full potential.

#### **GUIDELINES**

1. Curriculum delivery and planning expectations will be documented through:  
The School Education Plan  
Curriculum Statements in English, Mathematics, Physical Education/Physical Activities and Learning Pathways which incorporates The Arts, Health, Social Studies, Science and Technology.
2. All staff will be required to publish a timetable, which shows distribution of the curriculum. All staff will be required to record long and short term planning according to school operational procedures.
3. All students with special needs, including Gifted and Talented (GATE), will be identified and programmes will be implemented to support their learning
4. Issues which cause barriers to students' learning will be identified and the school will seek to implement appropriate strategies.
5. A variety of learning and teaching styles will be employed as appropriate to the needs of the students.
6. Student progress will be monitored using a range of assessment strategies and recorded as per procedures published in the Education Plan. Annual assessment guidelines will identify key areas for collecting school-wide and/or syndicate-wide data, to assess and report on student achievement.
7. All students will develop a portfolio of work, which provides evidence of achievement
8. Parents and students will have an opportunity to meet with the class teacher on at least two occasions per year. A written report of student achievement and progress will be sent home at the end of each year.
9. A self-review programme will ensure curriculum delivery is reviewed systematically.
10. The Principal will report annually to the BOT on identified curriculum areas and student achievement and progress.

11. Before the end of each year an Annual Plan setting out Curriculum Priorities Plans and Achievement Targets will be presented to the Board for approval.
12. Finance for curriculum delivery and resourcing will be a priority.
